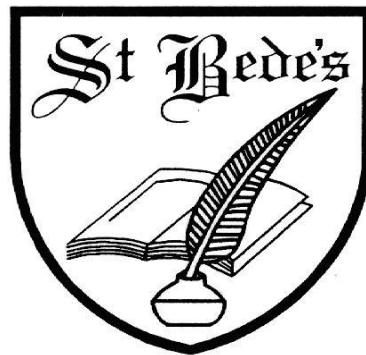

Parents / Carers Agreement

As parents we acknowledge that we are the first educators of our children and in signing this agreement we aim to work closely with the school to help our child to achieve his / her full potential at St Bede's.

Therefore I / we will try to:-

1. Support and uphold the aims and expectations outlined in this document.
2. See that my child attends school daily, on time, suitably dressed and well equipped.
3. Observe term dates and avoid taking family holidays in term time.
4. Ensure my child attends school during Statutory Tests and Assessment weeks, unless prevented by illness or other unavoidable causes.
5. Inform the school of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour before it becomes a major problem.
6. Support the Christian values of St Bede's school community.
7. Value the mission statement; *'One in unity, rich in diversity'* and all that it encompasses.
8. Give my child opportunities for home learning and support homework from school, creating an atmosphere in which learning and homework are valued.
9. Encourage my child to take responsibility for honouring commitments and completing tasks on time and providing the conditions under which this is achievable.
10. Take a lead role in listening to or supervising my child's reading, encouraging them to become more independent as they progress.
11. Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and uniform.
12. Attend Parents meetings and discussions about my child's progress.
13. Encourage my child to be enthusiastic about learning and to enjoy school by being positive about what the school is striving to achieve, and through praise, encouraging and acknowledging my child's worthy efforts and achievements.
14. Encourage my child to show kindness and consideration to others.
15. Read the information that is sent home from school and act upon it.
16. Support the Catholic community and the school Governors in their responsibilities for St Bede's School.

Pupil Agreement

9. Learn my spellings and complete any tasks my teacher sets for me to do at home in the time agreed.
10. Share my feelings honestly; show politeness to everyone; treat everyone with respect and kindness.
11. Know that there is always someone in St Bede's for me to talk to, in private, if I need to.
12. Behave well and sensibly so that we can all be happy and safe as we learn.
13. Take responsibility for my actions by thinking about what I do and what I say to others, and to have the courage to own up to and accept responsibility for the things I might do wrong. I will try to avoid any form of aggression; physical or verbal.
14. Observe all the school rules and treat everyone with the respect they deserve and respect their property.
15. Accept responsibility in my role as ambassador for the school when on school visits and in my leisure time.
